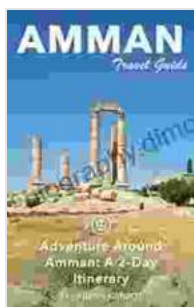

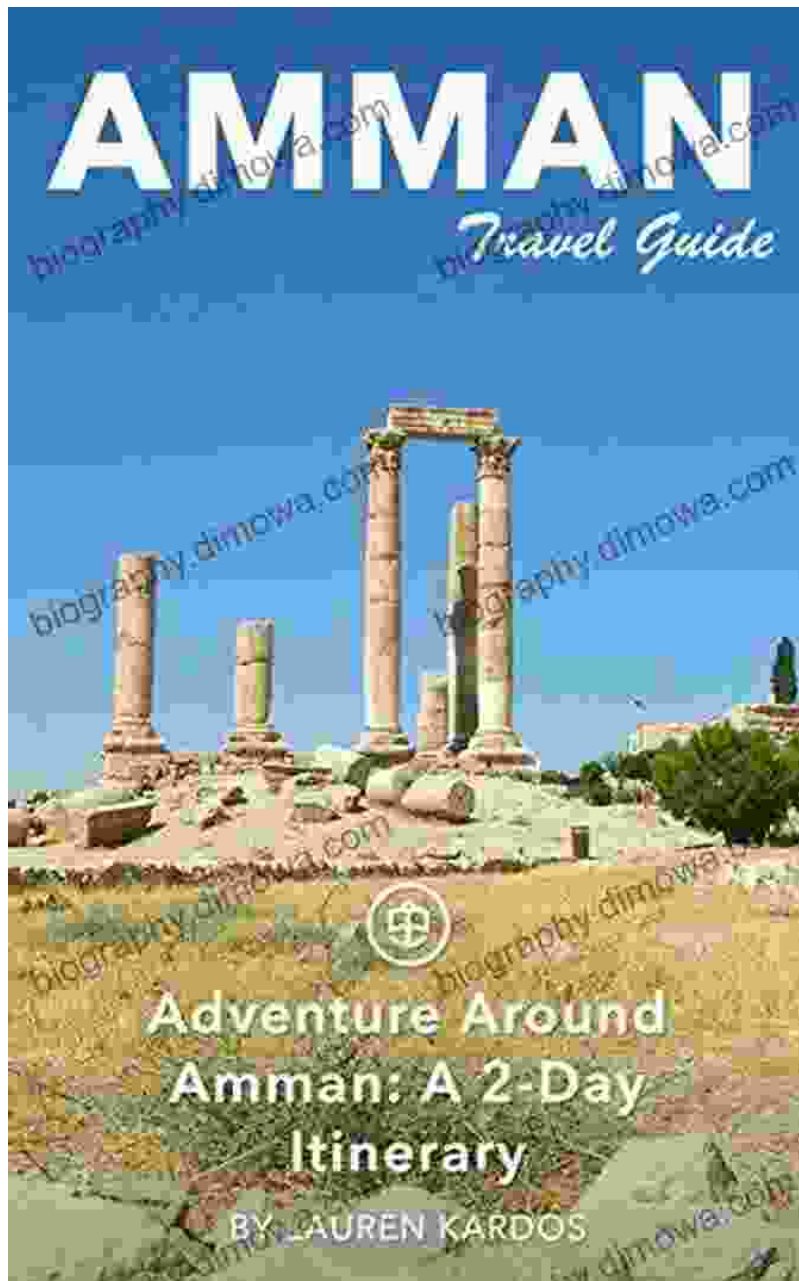
Jordan National Gallery of Fine Arts

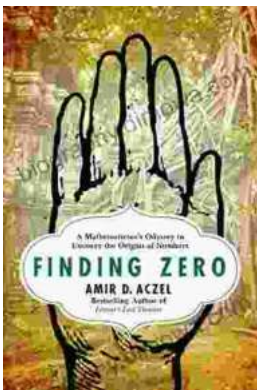
