- Diesel vehicles: £200
- Petrol vehicles (including hybrids): £12.50

Vehicles that do not meet the required standards will be subject to these daily charges.

Certain vehicles are exempt from the LEZ charges. These include:

- Vehicles registered as disabled tax class
- Vehicles used for emergency services or patient transport
- Historic vehicles over 40 years old

- Electric vehicles
- Hydrogen-powered vehicles

The ULEZ is a smaller zone within the LEZ and covers the same central London area. It operates 24 hours a day, every day of the year. The ULEZ applies to all vehicles that are subject to the LEZ, as well as motorcycles and mopeds.

Vehicles entering the ULEZ must meet stricter emission standards than the LEZ. The daily charges for non-compliant vehicles are:

- Diesel vehicles: £10
- Petrol vehicles: £12.50
- Motorcycles: £12.50

Vehicles that do not meet the required standards will be subject to these daily charges.

A limited number of vehicles are exempt from the ULEZ charges. These include:

- Electric vehicles
- Hydrogen-powered vehicles
- Vehicles used for emergency services or patient transport

- Vehicles registered as disabled tax class

A full list of exemptions can be found on the TfL website.

The LEZ and ULEZ are enforced using automatic number plate recognition (ANPR) cameras. These cameras capture the license plate of vehicles entering the zones and check their compliance. Vehicles that are not compliant and do not pay the required charges will be subject to a penalty charge notice (PCN). The PCN penalty is £160, reduced to £80 if paid within 14 days.

To help motorists comply with the LEZ and ULEZ, TfL provides several tools and resources:

- **LEZ and ULEZ Checker:** A free online tool that allows motorists to check if their vehicle meets the emission standards and is eligible for any exemptions.
- **LEZ and ULEZ Payment System:** A secure online system where motorists can pay the daily charges for entering the zones.
- **Sign Up for Reminders:** Motorists can sign up to receive email reminders about upcoming charges and renewal dates.

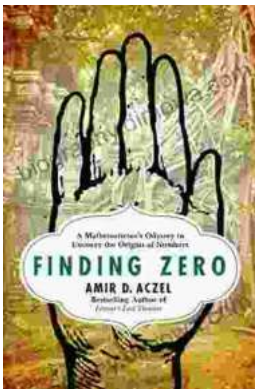
